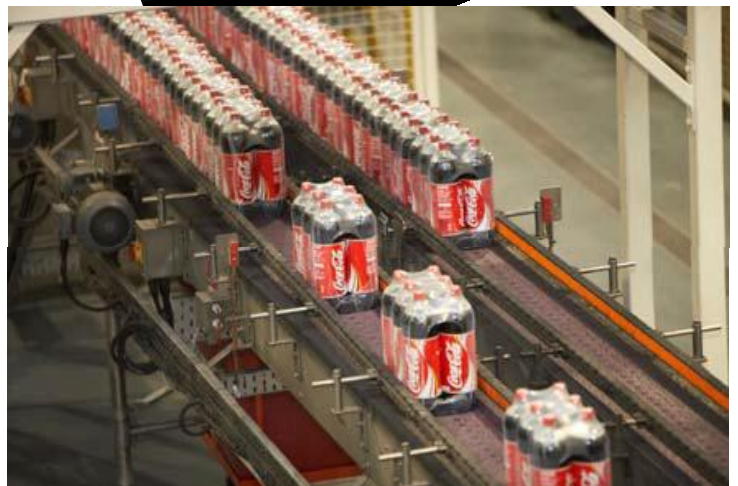


Edmonton Education Centre

Objectives

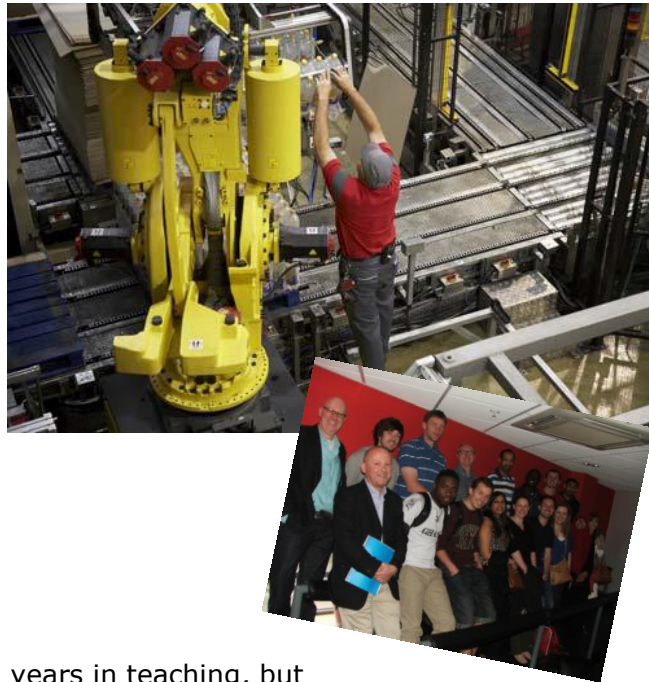
To bring industry alive for students giving them first-hand experience of the manufacturing and business world; to provide opportunities for students to make connections between work done in the classroom and real life business practices; to support student preparation for the world of work, and to enhance delivery of the national curriculum, supporting the work related and enterprise agenda.



Practicalities

- The trip is free
- The trip takes 2 hours
- We accommodate 2 visits a day: 10am-12pm and 1-3pm
- The maximum group size is 25 (23 students plus 2 teachers)
- The trip entails a short video, a themed presentation, an activity and a factory tour.
- There are 5 presentation themes for teachers to choose from (more detail on our website and booking form) : Business Studies, Marketing, Manufacturing & Production, D&T and Enterprise
- Teachers are advised to book well in advance (3-4 months/a term) as this is a very popular educational visit.
- We do not cater for primary schools (minimum age is 12 yrs)
